

The DePaul Clinic is a mental health clinic for children in the Catholic schools in Rochester and Monroe County. It offers diagnostic and treatment services for children with emotional problems and learning disabilities and consultative services to Catholic schools in Monroe County, Catholic Family Center, St. Joseph's Villa and other agencies under the Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Rochester, and Family Court.



Genesee Settlement House

Genesee Settlement House, completing its first year under a new administration, has begun to initiate new outreach programs and to shift its emphasis to a more formal and complete type of inter-agency cooperation. The House provides not only diagnostic and referral service but also intensive counseling to families with hard-core social and economic disadvantages.

St. Joseph's Villa

St. Joseph's Villa is a residential child care facility providing total treatment for neglected, emotionally upset and socially maladjusted children. The Villa, operated by the Sisters of St. Joseph, is located on a 40 acre wooded campus — one of the first cottage type group care facilities in the country. It has also established two boarding homes in Rochester, away from the campus.

Charles Settlement house

In addition to summer day camp and other activities, Charles Settlement House sponsors neighborhood groups in northwest Rochester, provides family counseling and self improvement services and helps with long range planning for neighborhood conservation.
