

Fleming Congregation To Burn Mortgage

Fleming — The parishioners of St. Isaac Jogues Church invite the public to join in a special Mass to be celebrated Sunday, May 4 at 4 p.m. by Father Raymond Wuest on the occasion of a mortgage burning ceremony and tenth anniversary of the church.

A special buffet in the church hall will follow the Mass.

The occasion also marks the 25th anniversary of the parish. The pastor, Father Daniel Hogan, will assist at the Mass. Father Wuest was pastor of the church during its construction 10 years ago.

The church is named after one of eight Jesuits martyred while doing missionary work among the Indians of North America during the Seventeenth Century.

Before the Catholics in Fleming had their new church, they worshipped first in a chapel that was torn down during highway construction, and then in a fire-house.

Priests who have served the parish include Fathers Francis Turner, William Tobin, Elmer Heindl and John Morgan. The late Father Lee Hastings also was a pastor.

A special commemorative booklet has been issued.
