

Organization Formed To Help Bosco House

A new organization, BRETHgivers, is being formed to give financial assistance to Bosco House which is the headquarters for the new Special Education Department of the diocese. Special Children will receive religious education through a CCD Program created for them.

Some 70 children are now enrolled in classes at the three existing centers at St. Charles, St. Ambrose, and Good Shepherd parishes. Before actual classes can be held at Bosco House, a training course will be given for prospective teachers.

There are many financial bur-

dens at this time, mainly because of the age of the house and needed remodeling. The future plans for Bosco House are many. For the present it is hoped that the forming of BRETHgivers will enable the director, Father E. Charles Bauer, to bring Bosco House to the fullest extent of his

expectations. The name BRETHgivers originates from the meaning of Bosco House — Bring Religious Education To the Handicapped.
