An International Boutique, with imported gifts from all over the world, will be a highlight of the sale.

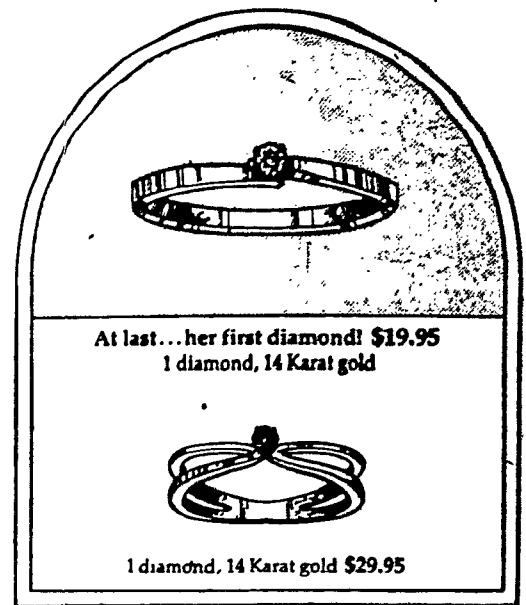

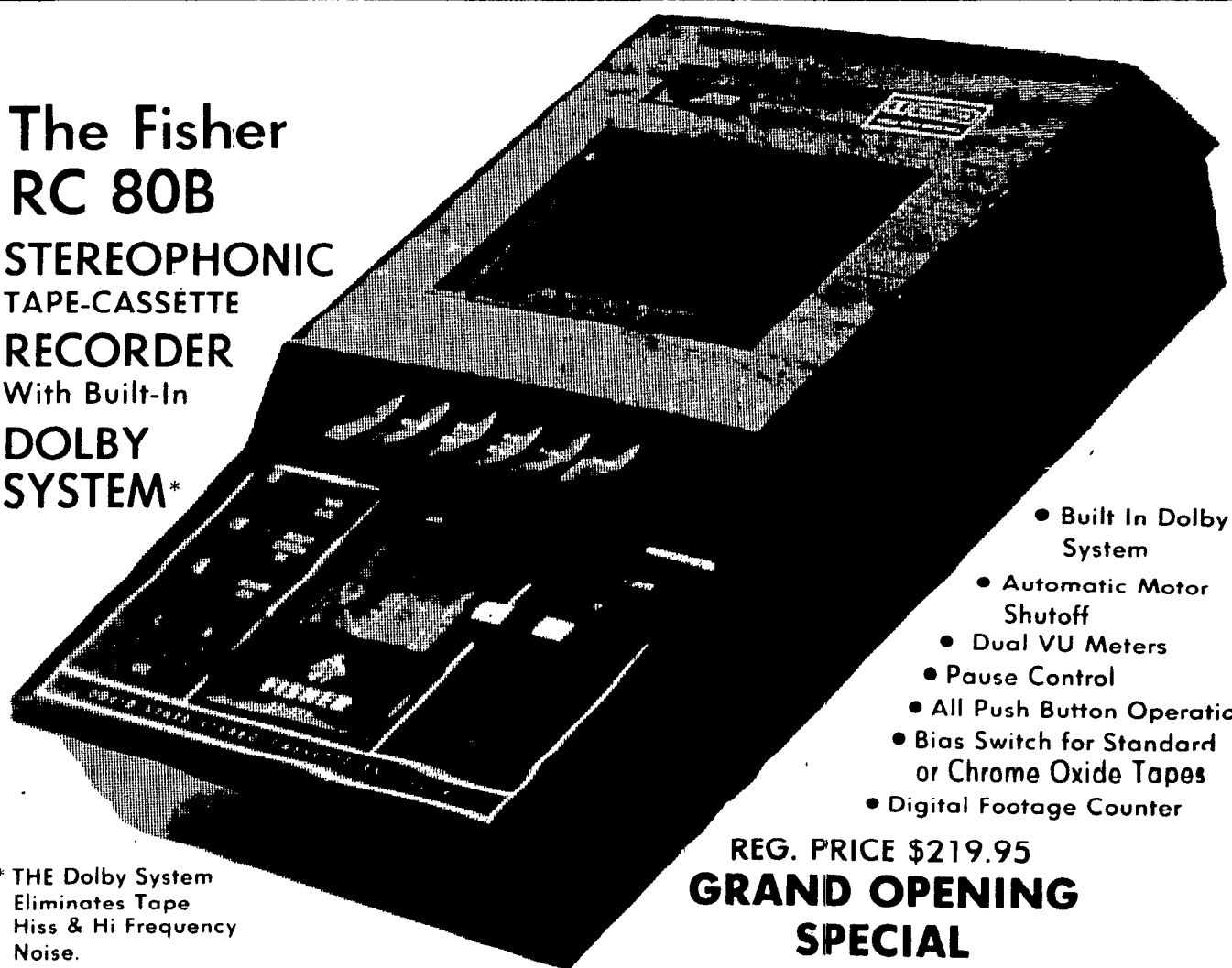

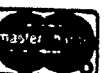
