



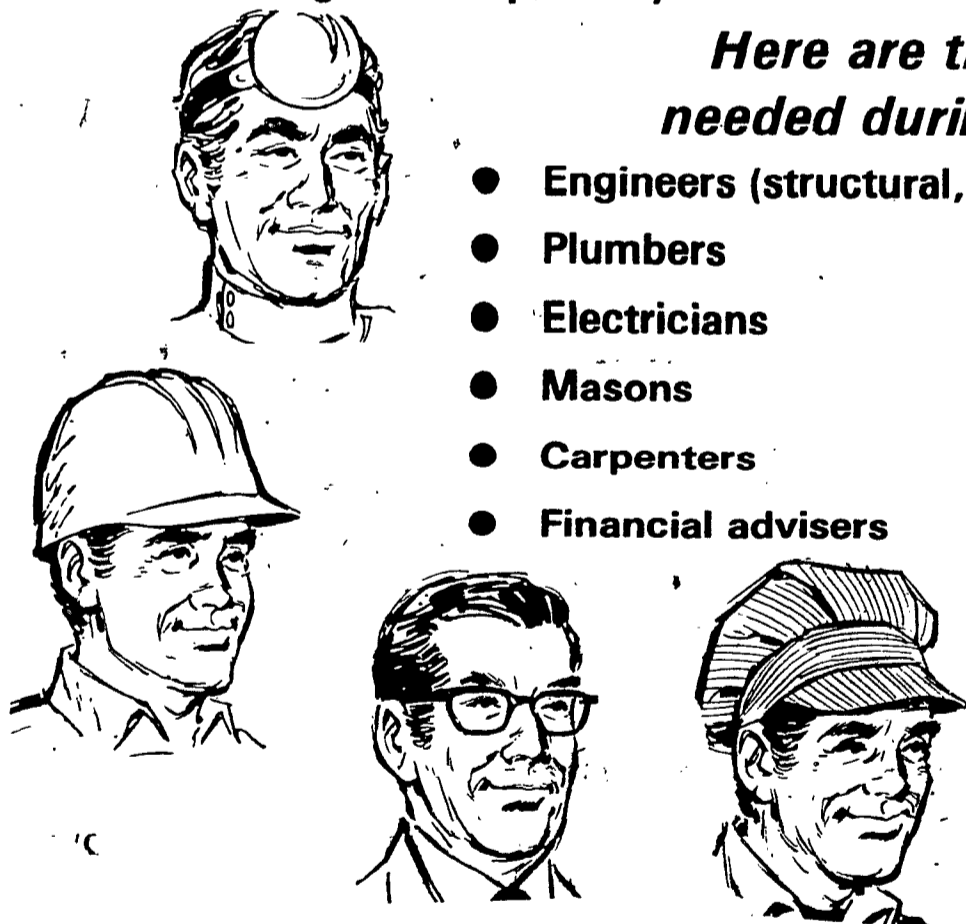
BLUEPRINT SAVE A FAMILY IN THE SOUTHERN TIER
