

Trumansburg Centennial

The village of Trumansburg (or 'Tremen-dous-burg' — as it is fondly called by its citizens) is celebrating its Centennial this week. Each day there will be a special program, ranging from historic pageants written and performed by area high school students to beard judging.

A costume parade, a barber-shop quartet concert, barbecues, a luau, a folk rock concert, and square dances in the street are planned.

During the Depression, Trumansburg was one of the first communities to sponsor square dances in the village square to keep people home Saturday nights and to attract other people from outside.

A parachute drop by a detachment from the 101st Airborne Division and a fly-by of service jets from Rome Air Force base is planned.

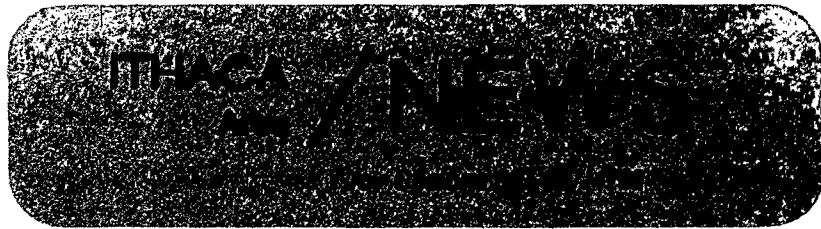

Priests Arrested In Colombia, Report Alleges

Bogota, Colombia (RNS) — Colombian military authorities have arrested three Roman Catholic priests and charged them with "abetting subversion," according to a Bogota radio report.

The broadcast did not identify the clerics, beyond saying that three priests in the Rio Negro area of northern Colombia had been arrested on Aug. 8 for "instigating peasants and attempting to disrupt public order."

Though the report gave no further details, it is believed that the priests may be members of the controversial Golconda Movement of Colombian clergy.

the fairgrounds from 3 til 5 p.m. where one may sit in the covered grand stand to watch and listen.

All local choirs will band together, with organ and brass band accompaniment. At 5:30 p.m. Rededication Ceremony will be held in front of the Presbyterian Church on Main Street. The invocation will be given by Father Albert Ryan, pastor of St. James; and speeches will be given by Mayor Peter Jager, Kathy Moynes, high school student; and Allan Treman, a direct descendant of Abner Treman, founder of Trumansburg.

After the speeches a time capsule will be placed under the centennial stone.

Benediction will be given by Calvary Baptist minister, Rev. Fred Johnson.

Father Ryan reports that St. James the Apostle Parish will celebrate its own centennial in October.
