

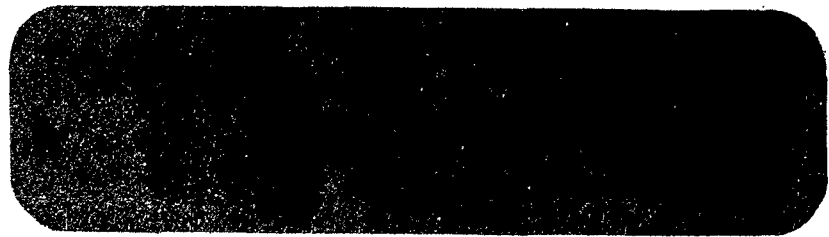
## Pastoral Council Group Names New Members

## Erroll Garner Shows Benefit Sigi Library

Erroll Garner, renowned jazz pianist, will give two benefit concerts, presented by the Friends of the Al Sigi Library, at the Nazareth College Arts Center on Monday and Tuesday, Nov. 20 and 21, at 8:30 p.m.

Proceeds from the concerts will be used to furnish a new library for the handicapped at the Al Sigi Center. Books, low bookshelves, and special audio-visual equipment, desks and chairs designed to accommodate wheelchairs are among the items that will be purchased for the library.

Garner is unique among musicians in that he cannot read or write a note of music. He does not even own a piano. Yet, with more than 200 compositions to his credit, the most popular among them "Misty," he ranks with the most prolific of American composers.
