Auburn - "It is essential that lay people exercise their full role in the mission of the church, for their spiritual good, for the spiritual good of the community in which they reside, and for the good of the Church so that they may assume with competence some activities formerly exercised almost exclusively by the priests or religious," commented Father Leo Lynch, pastor of St. Patrick's in Seneca Falls. He also is assistant coordinator representing Seneca County for the Year of Renewal efforts in the Auburn Region which includes Seneca and Cayuga counties.

"Regionalism can provide another avenue for increased lay participation. As coordinator representing a territory, it is my hope and intention to help make the laity of Seneca County responsible members of the Seneca/Cayuga Region, cooperating in all programs, and making the experience and expertise of our people available to the entire region.

Father Lynch pointed out while Seneca County is interested in following the diocesan_efforts of renewal and regionalism by joining with Cayuga County as part of the Auburn Region, it does mean a shift in emphasis as Seneca County could more easily be aligned with another region based on proximity.


He was a brother of Msgr. Joseph J. Sullivan, pastor of Holy Family, Auburn.




