Right to Life Meeting Held

Hornell — Goals of the area Pro Life Committee were explained to the Women's Board of St. James Mercy Hospital by Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Gibson of the Hornell Right to Life Committee at a meeting held recently in De-Sales Hall.


"We are appalled at the pre-dictions of deaths on the highways that took place during the long Thanksgiving Day week-end," Mr. Gibson states. "But the deaths of the unborn will surpass that number."

Liberal legalized abortion laws have made our state the abortions center of the United States, he continued.

A slide presentation on abortion showing fetal development established that the fetus is human from the start rather than after 24 weeks as New York State laws intimate. Many women and doctors feel that abortion is justifled because of poverty, the baby is unwanted or the mother is unmarried, according to the speaker.

"These reasons," Mrs. Gibson stated. "are really social problerns and society should be educated to solve them. Taking a human life is not the answer.

Many thoughtful people are ask-ing if legalized abortion is a step toward legalized killing of the handicapped, the incompetent and the elderly.'
