Like England, there will always be an Urzetta, especially in East Rochester.

It's not confusing if you happen to live in the village, but it's tough on the outside world.

First, there's Nick, Sam and Babe Urzetta, all "older" brothers and excellent athletes, for starters.

Nick is the area's perennial father baseball, football and basketball official; Sam is the former National Open golf champ; and Babe and Sam are both golf pros.

The three boys had sons; Nick is Carmen and Fred Urzetta's dad (Carmen is head basketball coach at Bishop Kearney and Fred is a well-respected basketball referee); Sam is Joe Urzetta's dad (Joe is a junior basketball performer at McQuaid); and Nick is Babe's son (Nick is a sophomore who plays at Kearney for cousin Carmen.)

It was Joe's and Nick's choice to attend McQuaid and Kearney, respectively.

Both youngsters, Joe, 16, and Nick, 15, are excellent athletes according to Carmen.

"They are both from the Urzetta mold," Carmen said.

Both happen to live on West Spruce St. in the village, a few blocks apart.

Joe and Nick played basketball against each other last year.

"They were JV's then, but midway during the season, I pulled Nick up to the varsity and he's been there since," Carmen said.

They'll meet again Friday, Jan. 5, when BK visits McQuaid.

Joe and Nick are good friends as well as cousins and both play a mean game of golf; Carmen said.

Joe stands about 5-7 and is a little better ballhandler, and Nick is 6-0, but perhaps a little better scorer, according to Carmen.

Where both boys will go to college is undecided, but Carmen suggests that if family tradition has anything to do with it, they may both end up at fellow villager Larry Wiese's St. Bonaventure University.

Carmen, who played for the Bonnies, began his Olean career as a freshman when Wiese started his varsity tenure as Bona head coach.

Joe's dad, Sam, also went to Bona, and is a former NCAA foul shooting champion.

The village influence is very much present at BK; Carmen works for Marty LaFica, BK athletic director, a former three sport East Rochester letter winner.

While Carmen didn't play basketball for St. Jerome's elementary school in the village, both Joe and Nick did. When Carmen was a teenager, St. Jerome's was just the village parish; it hadn't opened the school yet. (Carmen played his youth ball in the village's "Bidly" leagues, coached by a few guys named Urzetta, who else?)

Carmen's dad, Nick, a veteran area cage official, has never worked any of Carmen's ballgames, whether as a player at ER or as a coach at BK.
