## Diocese Launches Aid Fund Plea

The Diocese of Rochester is participating in a special Lenten campaign for funds which will culminate in a collection to be taken up on April 1.

Money raised will go to the American Catholic Overseas Fund which finances the work of Catholic Relief Services (CRS), the nation's bishops' aid and development agency.

At a recent meeting in Des Plaines, Ill., diocesan directors of the campaign mapped out strategy for promoting the solicitation.

Present at the meeting was Father William J. Flynn, di-

cesan director of CRS.

Also present was Romeo Maione, executive director of the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace, who told a luncheon group that the work of the fund should not only find "paternal ways of helping the poor," but should incorporate the poor into decision making processes.

The executive director of CRS, Bishop Edward E. Swannstrom, spoke to the group on the aid the agency has given to the Managua victims of the recent earthquake and cited an expanding commitment of the people of Southeast Asia.

It reported that 636 priests resigned their ministry during 1970. During 1970, the yearbook noted, worldwide totals disclosed that 6,839 priests had died and 7,697 had been ordained.
