Dr. Foley Joins McQuaid Board

Dr. Alice L. Foley, president of Nazareth College, has been elected to the Board of Trustees of McQuaid Jesuit High School, Father John J. McDonald, S.J., rector-president, announced last week.

A graduate of Nazareth College and the University of Rochester, Doctor Foley has also done graduate work at Columbia, Fordham and the University of Wisconsin. She has been a teacher, principal and director of instruction and assistant superintendent of the Brighton schools.

Doctor Foley is a member of the American Association of University Women, the board of trustees of Rochester Savings Bank and the National Association of Bank Women.

St. Bridget's Razing Story Termed False

Despite published reports of its impending demise, St. Bridget's Church will not soon fall to the wrecker's ball, asserts its pastor.

"It would be a couple of years before anything like that could be done," said Father Francis Vogt, when contacted about an article which reported that the parish might soon go out of existence.

"The church is not coming down soon," said Father Vogt, "nothing has been signed, and . . . that article caused a lot of trouble here."

Bishop Fulton Sheen proposed five years ago to give the parish property to the federal government as a housing site, but later withdrew the offer after considering the parishioners' reaction.

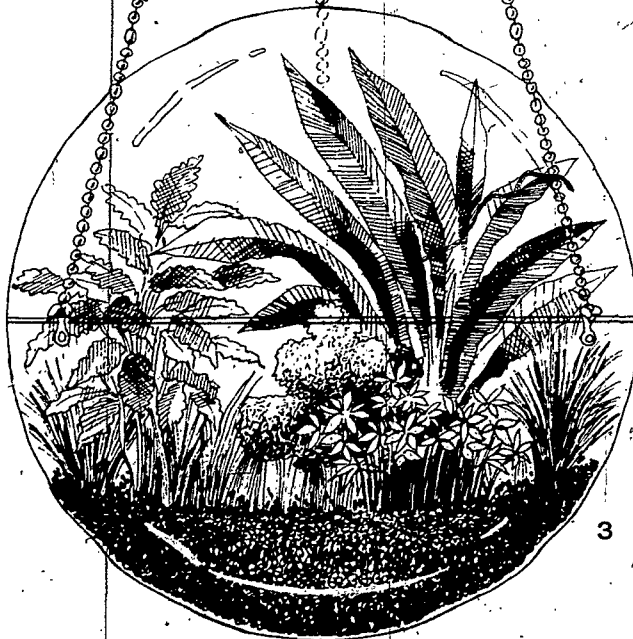
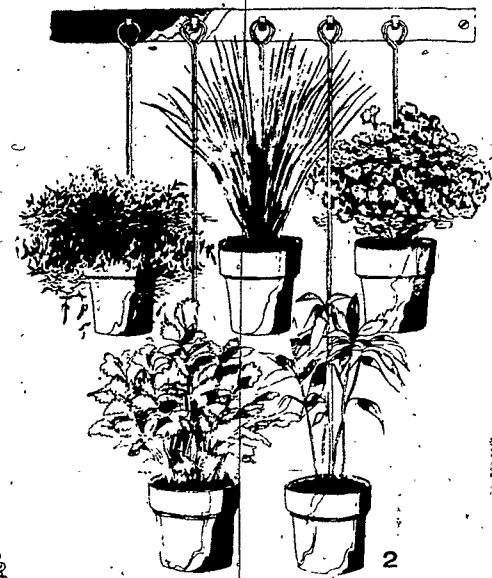
