

Duties The Men Must Handle

Bridegroom

The most important part of the groom's pre-marriage obligations is the ring. It is best to buy both the engagement ring and the wedding ring at the same time, either before or after the engagement.

The groom is also responsible for obtaining the license and should plan to do so well in advance for there is often a waiting period.

The groom must also:

• Compile a guest list of his family and friends, making sure there are no duplications with the bride's list.

• Choose the best man and ushers.

• Buy a gift for the future bride and the best man and ushers.

• Pay for the bride's bouquet and boutonnieres for himself and the best man. If, it is to be a formal wedding, he pays for the ties and gloves of the best man, ushers and himself.

• The groom-to-be pays for a corsage for his mother and new mother-in-law.

• He arranges for transportation to the wedding for the best man, and himself, and for transportation after the ceremony.

• He plans and pays for the wedding trip, and expenses involved.

• He provides the offering for the best man to give to the priest.

Flowers:

Beautiful Does Not Mean Expensive

Can anyone imagine a wedding without flowers? The bridesmaid's flowers, the floral decorations are all an integral part of the traditional wedding. A creative florist can help make each wedding unique, but a word of caution is in order for the bride who is thinking in terms of exotic flowers.

Unless money is no object, think in terms of more or less

local, seasonal flowers. Their abundance and availability makes them less expensive. They will look equally beautiful.

In order to achieve a truly impressive effect, the bride would be wise to work closely with her florist almost from the beginning of her planning.

Best Man

With all the attention focused on the bride, her attendants, her dress, her parties, her gifts and all the other things, the men in the wedding shouldn't be forgotten!

On the day of the wedding, the busiest person is probably the best man — that is, if he sees to all the things he should. One of the best ways to tend to everything is to have a checklist:

• Wake the bridegroom, if it's a daytime wedding.

• Help calm any jittery nerves of the bridegroom or whatever aid seems appropriate.

• Check the luggage for the wedding trip.

• Get all clothes for the wedding day together — formal clothes and traveling clothes.

• Deposit wedding clothes at wedding site.

• Deposit traveling clothes at reception site.

• If couple is to stay in town following the wedding, take luggage to their room and see that everything is in place; have flowers put in the room (optional); register for couple; take key to room.

• If the couple will leave town following the wedding, take the luggage to the car (which is safely hidden). After wedding, take couple to the car.

Additional checkpoints: Be sure bridegroom is dressed in plenty of time; locate missing clothes that are probably in full sight; put marriage license in bridegroom's pocket or wallet; get wedding ring and pastor's fee and put it in own pocket.
