Diocese to Hire Planner; Education Unit Revamped

Several diocesan changes have been announced by the Pastoral Office, including a revamping of the education department and establishment of a new Office of Planning.

Bishop Joseph L. Hogan has named Sister Mary James Lynch, SSJ, to be coordinator of educational services for the diocese. Sister Michael Lappetito, RSM, will assist Sister James as director of the Religious Education Department.

Sister James will be responsible for coordinating the divisions of general education and religious education, and for developing other educational services for the diocese especially as they relate to future parish and regional educational direction.

Sister Michael's division will be responsible for total parish education, including adults as well as children. New emphasis is planned in adult education.

Father Daniel Brent will remain in the capacity of superintendent of schools. Father Albert Shamon formerly vicar for education, will resume pastoral duties.

These changes come as a result of a May 22 meeting of Bishop Hogan, Auxiliary Bishops Dennis W. Hickey and John E. McCafferty and the interdepartmental Staff.

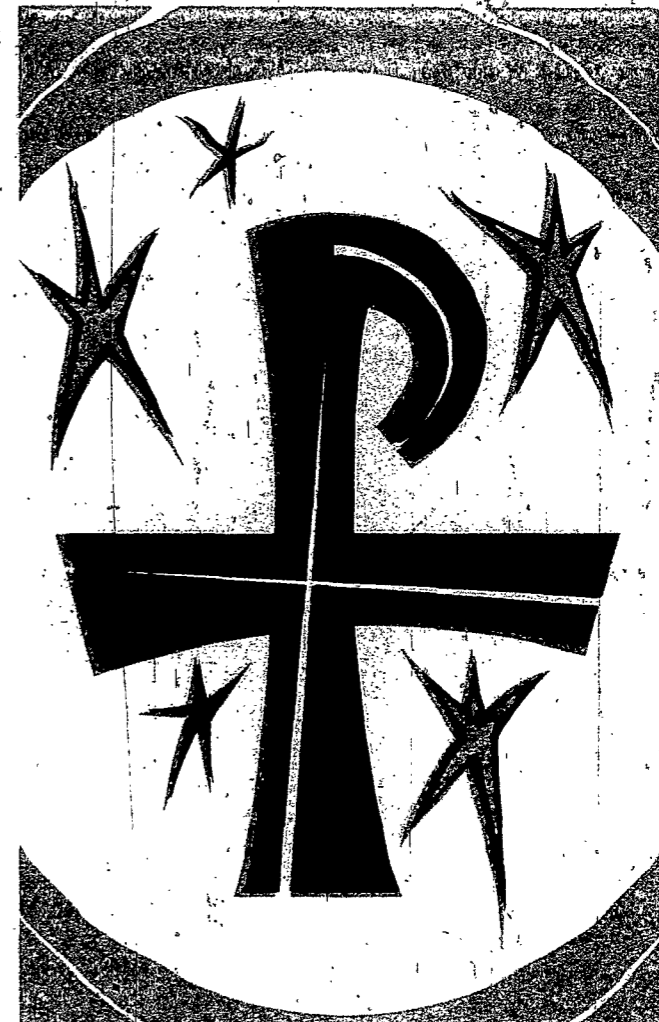
It was decided at the meeting to make several changes in diocesan management areas, which will "improve the pastoral office's accountability in the field," according to the bishop.

An evaluation of diocesan educational services was recently conducted by Bishop Hogan and the staff of the Department of Education. It was agreed upon to improve the administrative services of the department through reorganization. This will be carried out by Sister James, Sister Michael and Father Brent.

Sister James' appointment becomes effective June 1; Sister
