

Archdiocese Forms Board on Investing Ethics

St. Paul, Minn. — Establishment of a board of investment ethics for the Archdiocese of St. Paul-Minneapolis has been announced by Archbishop Coadjutor Leo C. Byrne.

He said the seven-member board will be responsible for applying a recently-developed set of guidelines to investment activities of the Archdiocese.

The guidelines provide that the Archdiocese will not invest in companies which are significantly involved in:

— The manufacture of weapons of war and the destruction of human life.

— Activities causing social injury to consumers, employees or others through violation of law, exploitation or discrimination.

— Providing products or services contrary to the moral teachings of the Catholic Church.

The archbishop said he has asked the new board to review the investment portfolio of the Archdiocese in light of these guidelines. He also has urged other Archdiocese-related corporations to apply the guidelines to their own investment activity.

Q.—An April, 1973, Courier said a lot on mixed marriages. I have a "mixed marriage." Mixed because one of us was divorced, not allowed to be married in the Catholic Church, harassed by the Catholic partner's relatives, looked on as a "queer" due to their beliefs, and not considered married. Now, after years of proving I was "okay," I am accepted but put aside when weddings, funerals, etc., come along as though I was an "extra chair" to be placed along the wall and used only as a last resort.

How about our feelings? — the un-Catholic, the divorced partner who may have been married before and did have children from this marriage?

Too often [you may not believe this] the Catholic one would overlook the laws of his or her Church, saying he will get married "later" in the Church. Anything, just to be married. Years go by — they have children, having them baptized Catholic, confirmed, the works. Not once does the Catholic partner ask if his or her Protestant partner wanted to go to be a part of their religious life. That is the unspoken life, not to be mentioned. In fact, even death is not mentioned. What about that? What happens to the un-Catholic partner in this part of life [or death as you may put it]?

These people of mixed marriages are put aside. Once again relatives do the talking, the thinking. The bereaved one [a Protestant or former divorced person] is not considered even in picking the burial place. Can't be side by side. Impossible.
