

Urban League National Leader To Speak Here

Vernon E. Jordan Jr., executive director of the National Urban League — the largest social service and civil rights agency in the world — will speak in Rochester on Monday, Nov. 19, as part of the local organization's annual membership drive.

Jordan will be the featured

speaker at a 7 p.m. banquet at the Holiday Inn Downtown.

The 37-year-old attorney and successor to Whitney Young, is expected to talk about the major concerns of minorities.

In August of this year, he told

Southern Christian Leadership Conference delegates in Indianapolis that, "What white America has experienced as a recession, black America has felt as a depression.

"Black income is declining in relation to white income, and in

the decade since we marched for jobs and freedom the median income gap between whites and blacks has grown from \$3,000 in 1963 to \$4,700.

"Black earnings are not only falling behind white earnings, they are falling far behind the

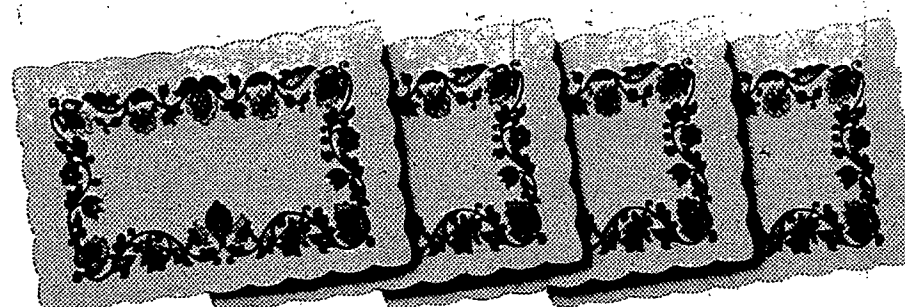
most elementary decent living standards. The typical black family earns about \$700 less than the government's own minimum acceptable living standard, so for the majority of black Americans, boasts of this nation's high living standards are a grotesque and bitter joke."
