African Confers With Pope Paul

Vatican City [RNS] — Burundi's new ambassador to the Holy See has assured Pope Paul VI that "peace now reigns" in the tiny East African country, "Thanks to the important contributions made by the churches in Burundi."

Ambassador Adolf Bingana presented his credentials to the Pope at a special audience on Nov. 15.

In April 1972, the Republic of Burundi was the scene of one of the worst ethnic wars in modern African history. In an attempted coup by the Hutu (tribal) majority, and an ensuing counter-offensive by the ruling Tutsi, some 120,000 people were killed.

Last May, fighting again erupted between Hutu rebels and the Tutsis in Burundi. Later reports indicated that between

10,000 and 20,000 Hutus were killed in Tutsi reprisals.

Alluding to the events in Burundi, Pope Paul told the ambassador: "Like your country's Catholic bishops, you too are greatly concerned about the events that have deeply disturbed the lives of your compatriots."

The pontiff insisted that a necessary condition for "full development" in Burundi was "concord and friendship between the different groups of the country's population," and added:

"We wish to offer our assistance, both spiritual and material, to all the victims, and to make our contribution with all the means at our disposal for the re-establishment of a lasting peace."
