## Have You Seen This Man? (Call 546-2000)

This is an artist's sketch of a man seen near a parked car last week in the vicinity of the spot in Macedon where the body of Michelle Maenza, 11, was found Nov. 28. The girl was the victim of a rape-slaying.

The slaying was the third in a series of similar crimes in the Rochester area. Carmen Colon, 10, and Wanda Walkowicz, 11, were the previous victims.

Police evidence indicates a beige car may have been used in the most recent slaying. The Courier-Journal asks all its readers to study the sketch, review all the evidence concerning the three slayings, then comb their memories for any possible clue to aid the police in their search.

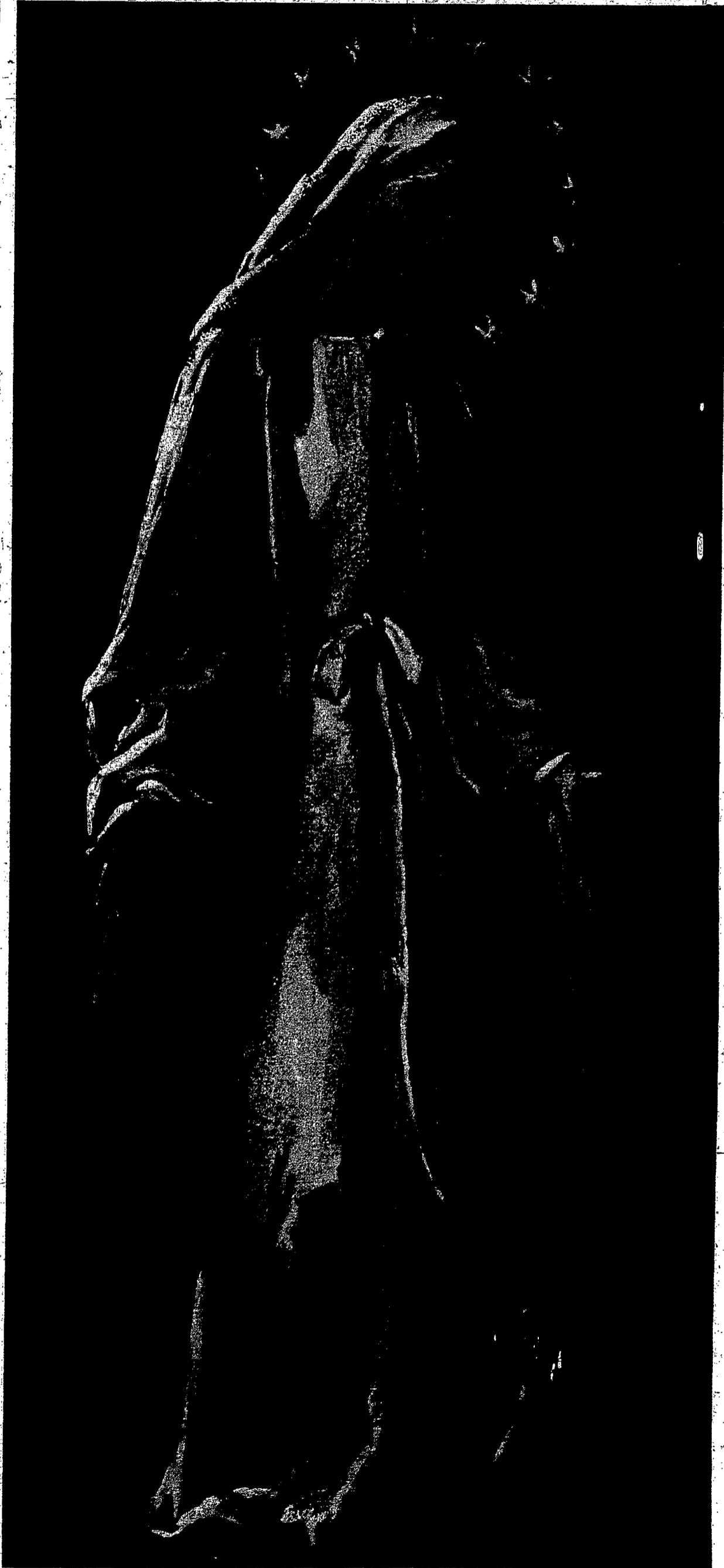
## Behold Your Mother
