Rochester Man Elected by Presbyterians

Newark, N.J. [RNS] — The Rev. Conrad H. Massa, a pastor in Rochester, N.Y., was elected moderator of the new Synod of the Northeast of the United Presbyterian Church at its constituting assembly here.

By a vote of 113-80, he won election over the Rev. C. Mike Jousan Jr., of Leonia, N.J., who had been the candidate of the nominating committee. Mr. Massa was nominated from the floor.

Since 1966, Mr. Massa has been pastor of First Presbyterian church in Rochester. He had previously been pastor of Old First Presbyterian church in Newark, and of Elmwood church in East Orange, N.J.

Center Proposed for Northwest

A proposal is being circulated throughout the Northwest Region to establish an instructional center at Sacred Heart Convent for religion teachers in the area. The region covers 18 parishes and four other institutions.

The proposal for the center, a place for the storage and retrieval of audiovisual materials, was delivered to the region's General Assembly meeting in December by Father Foster Rogers. Father Leon Hart, CSB, introduced the idea.

Father Rogers' proposal suggests an \$11,000 budget to come from regular members of the center and fees charged others for its use.

A \$4,000 yearly salary for a full-time executive secretary of the

unit is the largest item in the proposed budget.

The executive secretary's duties, the proposal states, are to organize the center with advice from the director, and to see that the daily work of the center is completed, including administrative, secretarial, and volunteer.

It is expected that the next regional General Assembly, slated for Feb. 20, will debate the issue.
