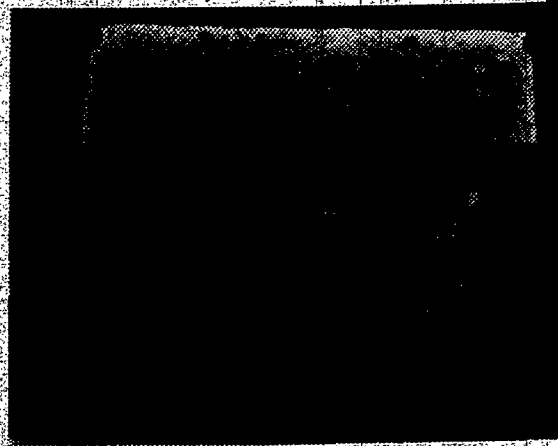
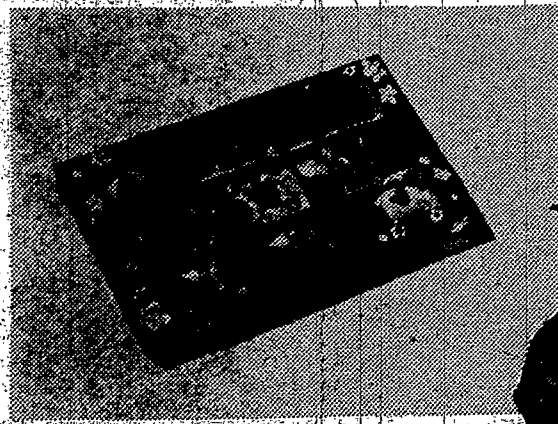
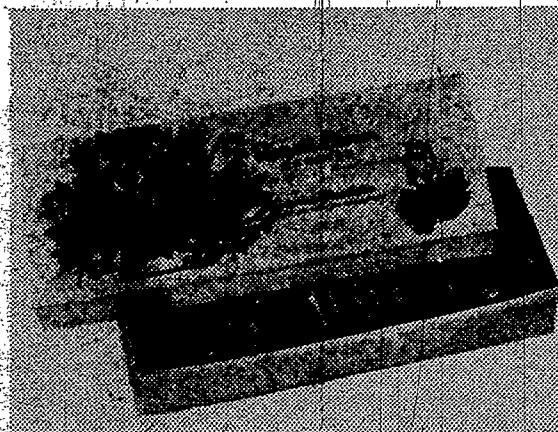
### CHARITY BALL
