## Army Seizes Control in Portugal

Soldiers and military vehicles, under orders from a group of army officers that seized control of Portugal, take up positions near the Army Ministry in Lisbon. The officers, proclaiming a desire to bring democracy to Portugal and peace to her African territories, seized control of key government ministries in the early morning (April 25) and by late afternoon announced that Premier Marcello Caetano had surrendered. The overthrow of Dr. Caetano ended a dictatorial regime instituted by the late Antonio de Oliveira Salazar, who became Premier in 1928.

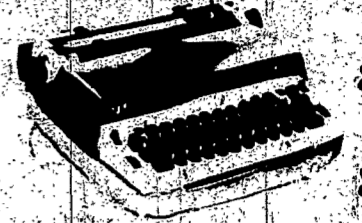
