Four Convicted In Burglaries

Vatican City (RNS) — A Vatican City court has convicted four men of burglarizing apartments of the Apostolic Palace, including Pope Paul's own chambers.

The four, onetime repairmen for the Vatican's telephone exchange, were given sentences that ranged from three years in jail to a \$400 fine.

They were charged with stealing or receiving a reported \$10,000 worth of objects d'art in a series of burglaries.

According to one report, the defendants may benefit from a papal amnesty. Pope Paul recently called on nations throughout the world to grant amnesty to political and other prisoners as an act of clemency befitting the 1975 Holy Year.

The Vatican apartments were looted in 1969, while Pope Paul was at his summer residence in Castelgandolfo, 15 miles southeast of Rome.

In May 1973, a Vatican security agent chanced to see a one-of-a-kind religious medallion in the window of a Roman coin shop. It had been missing from the Pope's apartment since 1969.

The original seller was traced to his job at the Vatican telephone exchange. Within a month, three other telephone men had been arrested.

In addition to the Pope's apartment, that of his secretary, Msgr. Pasquale Macchi, had also been fleeced of various objects, including coins, a jeweled pectoral cross and a gold watch.

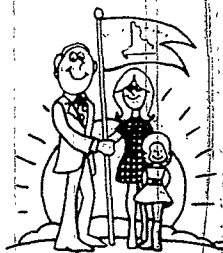
FACULTY DINNER

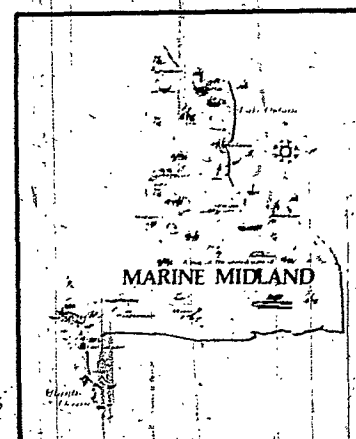
