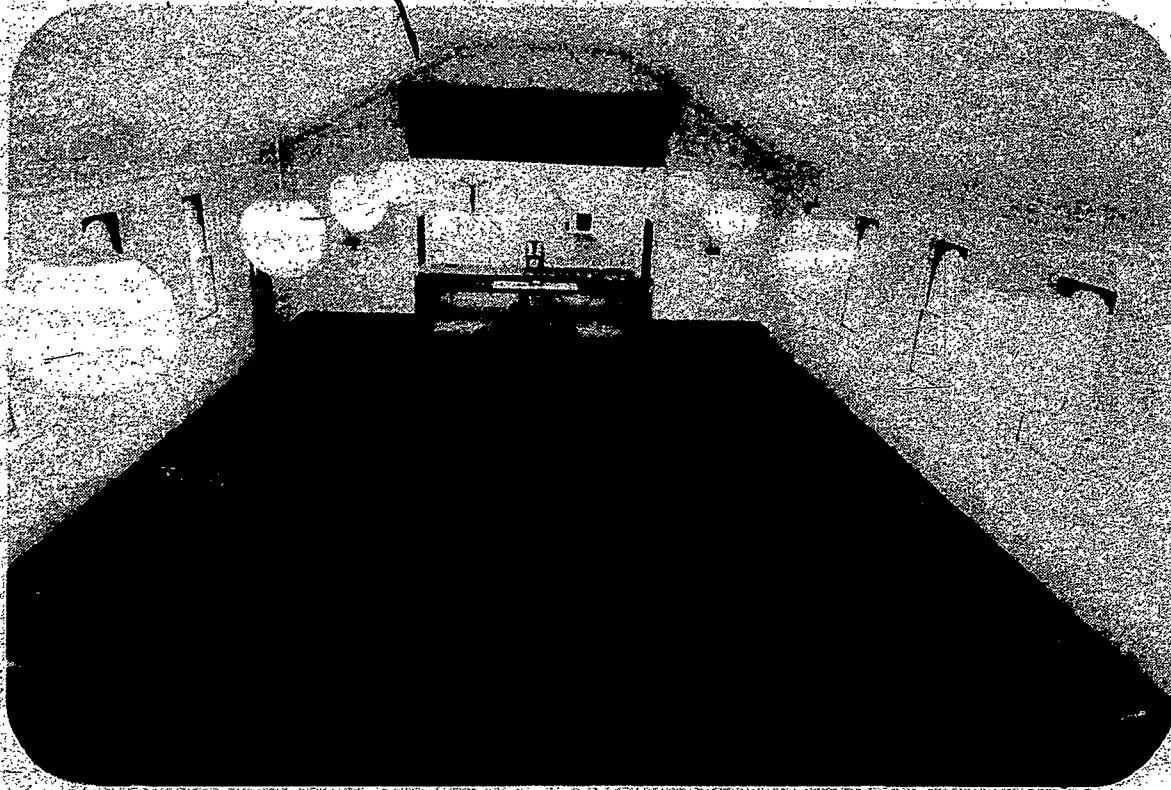




Renewal

Renovation work begun last winter has recently been completed at the Church of the Good Shepherd in Henrietta. The floor plan of the church was altered, the sanctuary floor was extended and the altar thrust forward into the nave so that the people would feel more a part of the liturgy. New lighting, carpeting, paint, a new sound system and a new confessional room completed the renovation. Approximately \$60,000 in renovation expense was saved by 3,250 man-hours of labor donated by parishioners.
