Abortion Curb Okayed

Albany [RNS] — Gov. Malcolm Wilson has signed into law a bill placing curbs on the state's liberal abortion law which was passed four years ago.

Under the new measure, abortions after the 12th week of pregnancy must be performed in

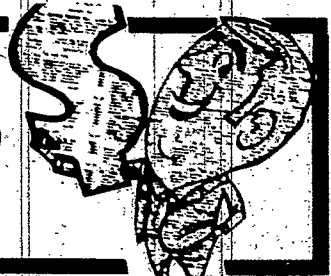
a hospital, and only on an in-patient basis.

The new law also requires that a second physician be present during abortions performed after the 20th week of pregnancy "to take control of and provide immediate medical care for any live birth that is a result of the abortion."

Gov. Wilson also signed bills redefining the obscenity statutes, extending the prisoner furlough program, and prohibiting discrimination against the mentally and physically handicapped in employment, housing and places of public accommodation.
