Bishops' Spokesman Hails House IDA Vote

Washington — Bishop James S. Rausch, general secretary of the United States Catholic Conference, said the House of Representatives in approving a \$1.5 billion contribution to the International Development Association (IDA), "has shown a welcome awareness of this country's proper role in an increasingly interdependent world."

On July 2 the House, reversing its earlier stand, voted 225-140 in favor of the contribution to IDA, an agency of the World Bank established to help the 21 poorest

nations by providing long-term, low-interest, developmental assistance. The Senate had previously passed the bill, and differences between the House and Senate versions are expected to be worked out in committee.

Last February, when the House voted overwhelmingly to cut off funds for the IDA, Bishop Rausch warned that the action could have a "devastating effect on the lives of the world's most desperate people," and urged the House to reconsider its vote.

"We, for our part," he said then,

"will communicate our deep concern about this issue and urge American Catholics to support the replenishment of the International Development."

LIBRARY RAISES RESERVE RATES
