Legion of Mary Explained

The Legion of Mary is a lay apostolic organization which has as its primary object the sanc-tification of its members through prayer and an active participation in the work of the Church in cooperation with bishop and

It was founded in Ireland more than 50 years ago, and Dublin continues to be the site of the governing council, the "Concilium". The legion in this Diocese is under the jurisdiction of the "Senatus" in New York City, which has 20 councils throughout New York State and northern New Jersey. northern New Jersey.

In February 1974, Cardinal

Terence Cooke appointed Father Thomas A. Nielson, of Manhattan, spiritual director of the New York Regional Senatus.
He replaces Msgr. Edward J.
Reynolds who had served as spiritual director since 1958, and who has now been assigned pastor of St. Patrick's in Verplanck, N.Y.

The legion is working in about 53 parishes in the Rochester diocese with approximately 575 active members. These members attend weekly meetings which combine prayer and work, and in addition carry out a 2-hour weekly work assignment. In six parishes there also is a Junior Legion whose members follow

the same system.

Some of the types of works that the priests have asked their Legionaries to become involved in are: teaching CCD; taking parish census; visiting the sick, elderly, shut-ins in both homes and hospitals; visiting prisoners in both Auburn Correctional Facility and the Monroe County Jail; contacting lapsed Catholics; preparing both children and adults for First Communion, Confirmation and Marriage; visiting inner city homes visiting inner city homes regardless of religious affiliations; working with the people in migrant camps, and many, many

For the past several years, some

members have spent their vacation in apostolic projects in Appalachia, in migrant camps, at Lourdes, France, etc. This vacation apostolate is intended to help the priests in distant areas where he has less help and a great need to spread the word of God.

In addition to active membership, there also is an auxiliary membership. This consists of saying the Rosary and a few short additional prayers daily. People unable to undertake active membership are encouraged to become auxiliary members on whose prayers the active members rely very heavily.

Membership in the Legion of

Mary (both active and auxiliary) is open to Catholic men and women of all ages and to Junior between the ages of 8 and 18. 


