After 120 years, St. Bridget's was closing its school doors.

Under the consolidation plan of the Council of Inner City Parishes (CICP), St. Bridget's students and supplies are being transferred to St. Michael's elementary school. St. Michael's has been converted from a junior high to a school for grades K through Six.

At 9:30 last Wednesday morning, two trucks from the Vasile Construction Co. and two diocesan pick-up trucks pulled into St. Bridget's parking lot. Volunteers from the two parishes, Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Immaculate Conception and Holy Redeemer helped load and unload "eight million things."

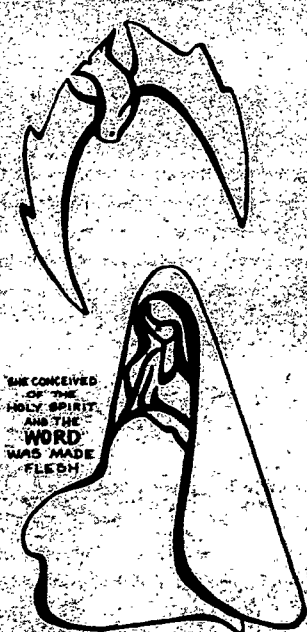
