Elmira — The 21st annual Mt. Saviour Monastery Fall Festival will be held Sunday, Sept. 15. Featured will be the Southside High School Choral Group, which just returned from a three-week concert tour in the Soviet Union. The Celebrate Life Group of Horseheads and the Rochester Sisters of St. Joseph Chorale will join the monks of Mt. Saviour in singing an outdoor concelebrated Mass at 10 a.m. During the afternoon the Mark Twain Cadets Drum and Bugle Corps will perform as well as the choir of the Church of God in Christ, Elmira, under the direction of Cephus McGee. Joseph Augustin will wander through the crowd playing the accordion.

Raymond Defendorf will be master of ceremonies at the

festival, which attracts thousands to the monastery each year.

A children's program with supervised baby sitting will include a sand pile, fish pond, arts and craft activities, pony, hay and fire engine rides, magician and clown.

The street of shops will feature the popular Christmas shop, hand made boutique, bake shop, teenage booth, plants, flowers, jams & jellies and produce of the farm at the Benedictine monastery as well as a "Try or Buy" and an Odd and Old shop.

An arts and craft exhibit and show with demonstrations will include many local artists, media including water colors and

graphics, book-binding, ceramics, sculpture, macrame, engraved glass, weaving, leather work, quilting and silver work.

The cloister of the monastery will be open to the public. On display will be the recently donated 19th Century Tibetan Thangka, a wall hanging used by Hindus and Buddhists for meditation.

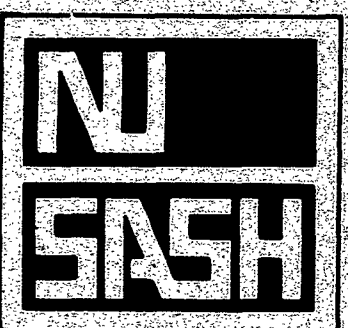
