Msgr. Gefell Cites Gospel In Hospitality Fund Drive

Auburn - "We are to reach out to those in need as we make our religious" tenets part of our everyday life," said Msgr. Joseph G. Gefell, in support of current fund raising for the Auburn Hospitality Center.

Msgr. Gefell, pastor of St. Alphonsas, is coordinator for the Cayuga-Seneca Region.

As regional coordinator, he said, "It is my special responsibility to proclaim the gospel in all matters, and the message of the gospel is perfectly clear. The Hospitality Center project takes on an immediacy, as this community, with a correctional facility does not have adequate facilities for visitors to the institution.

"The occasion to help people in need gives us a unique opportunity to fulfill the Gospel message — naked and you clothed me, sick and in prison, and you visited. When you did it to these the least of my brothers,

you were doing it to me."

The Hospitality Center is across from the prison. It was developed by civic and church groups in a former service station for the use of visitors to the city, many of whom come from afar to see their relatives and friends at the prison.

The center, open daily under the direction of Keith Batman and volunteers, has served 4,500 people since December 1972.

It provides shelter, snacks and babysitting service. It offers information about prison regulations, help with visit-related problems, emergency loans and coordination of charter buses from metropolitan areas:

Msgr. Gefell said the Episcopal Churchwomen of Central New York will match funds raised in the community up to \$2,500. The Diocesan Office of Human Development will match funds raised in Cayuga County parishes up to \$2,500, as additional incentive.


