Honduras Relief Collection Set

Catholic Relief Services and Church World Relief have asked local congregations to contribute this Sunday, Oct. 6, to a special fund for the Honduras hurricane victims.

Catholics will be observing Respect Life Sunday. Many Protestant churches will mark the date as World Communion Sunday, "a most appropriate date for the relief collection," according to Rev. Henry Atwell, director of Genesee Ecumenical Ministries.

He said a letter asking congregations "to respond in generous Christian charity" had been sent to more than 600 churches in the ten-county GEM area.

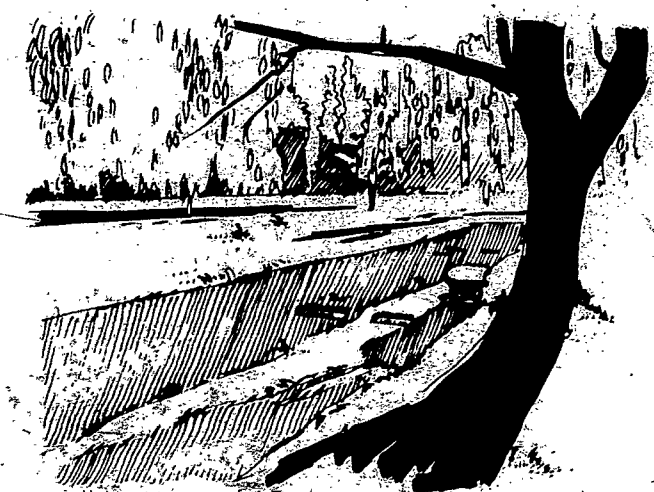
