records he made in the United States.

The memorial was erected near the ruined cottage where Coleman was born in 1892. The violinist emigrated at the age of 17 and died at 53 in New York, "in exile" the monument inscription notes.

Irish newspapers received by the Flahertys reported that 800 to 1,000 gathered for the unveiling of the memorial, a gift of the Coleman Traditional Society and the Old Coleman Society. Speakers extolled the native son as "the greatest exponent of our national music" and the man who "released Irish music from bondage."

Father Patrick Peyton, CC, of Killaville, a nephew of the Rosary Crusade priest, blessed the monument and was a celebrant of the memorial Mass.
