# Diocesan Pilgrimage Set

About 1,000 persons from throughout the diocese are expected to participate in the diocesan pilgrimage for Renewal and Reconciliation which will take place at 2:30 p.m. at Sacred Heart Cathedral next Sunday, Oct. 27.

Each parish will pledge in written form a special plan for reconciliation and these letters will be delivered to Bishop Joseph L. Hogan at the offertory during the Mass.

The Mass itself will be celebrated by Bishop Hogan, Auxiliary Bishops Dennis W. Hickey and John E. McCafferty, and the 10 regional coordinators.

In addition, Bishop James E. Kearney will lead special Holy Year prayers.

## 250 Join Pilgrimage at St. Andrew's

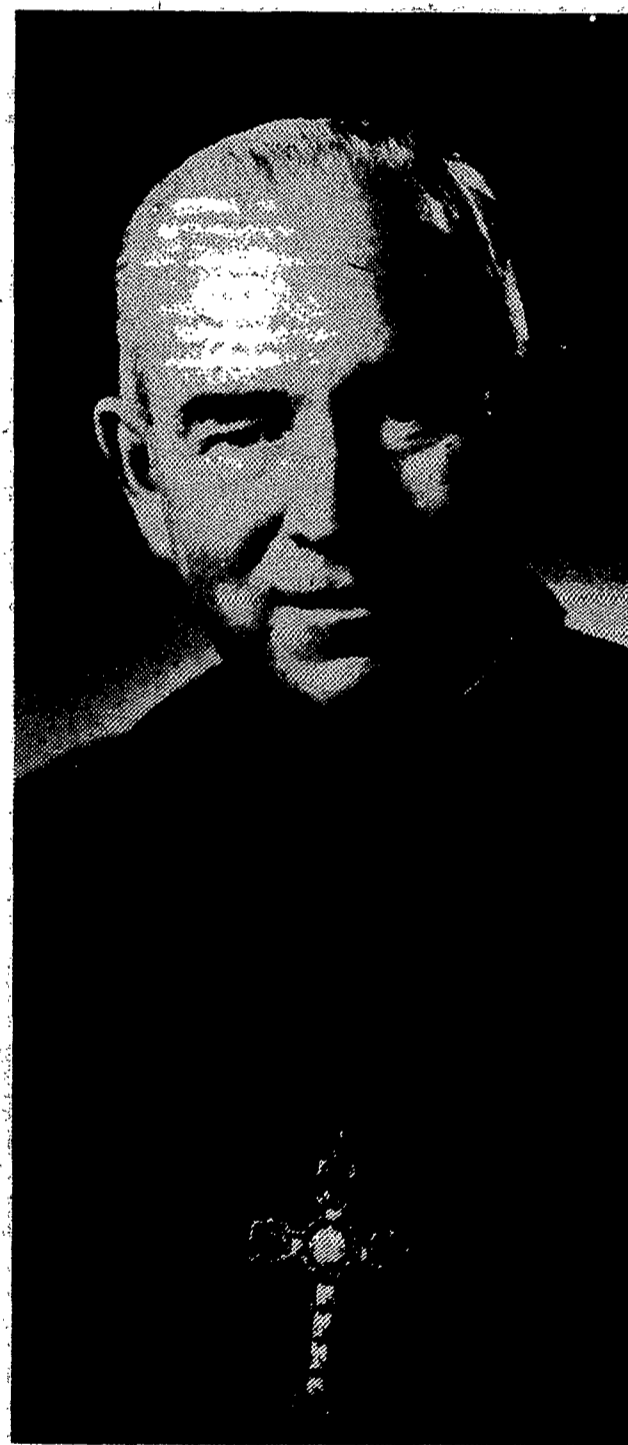
