Auburn - The statue of Our Lady of Fatima was greeted by standing room only crowds in the four city churches during the first part of its pilgrimage through the diocese.

An all night vigil at St. Aloysius averaged about 50 visitors an, hour. The statue was carried in procession from St. Hyacinth's Church to Holy Family, where there were continuing prayers. Fifteen decades of the rosary were recited and confessions and Mass concluded the services. The
