**Sr. Magdalena Notes
37 Years in Missions**

Rochester Maryknoll Sister Magdalena Urlacher has worked on mainland China and in Taiwan for the past 37 years and although the two are separated geographically, the people to whom Sister ministers are the same. Hakka speaking Chinese. Sister Magdalena, a nurse as well as catechist, works at both professions.

For the past year Sister has been stationed at Our Lady of Maryknoll Clinic at Changhua located in the central part of Taiwan. The clinic serves poor and low income families with particular emphasis on prenatal and postnatal nutrition programs.

Widespread protein

malnutrition is combated by feeding programs and on-the-spot education. "Grandmothers in a matriarchal society have to be shown that other foods besides mothers' milk would not harm their precious heirs," says Sister. To assure that the babies were actually being fed the enriched diet, they were fed at the clinic under the watchful eye of an aide.

Pregnant women are given supplementary iron, vitamins and protein and likewise instructed on the value of bean curd, fish and other cheap sources of protein. The prenatal clinics are popular with the women and each month there is a party to celebrate the mothers and

newborns. The clinic becomes a social center as the mother and her child visit weekly for diet supplements and further teaching by demonstration.

Sister Magdalena was born in Rochester and attended East High School and Nazareth Academy. Prior to her entrance into Maryknoll from Our Lady of Perpetual Help parish in 1927, she was employed by the Security Trust Company, Rochester.

After profession, she earned a diploma in nursing from Providence Hospital, Seattle, Wash. In 1935 she was assigned to south China where she remained until she was expelled in 1951. She next served two years at the Maryknoll Sisters Hospital in Pusan, Korea, and another two in refugee work in Hong Kong. She has been in Taiwan since 1955.

Sister Magdalena, daughter of the late Michael and Magdalena Urlacher, has one brother, George Urlacher, who lives in Rochester.

Maryknoll Sisters began work in Taiwan (formerly Formosa) in 1953 and 31 Sisters are now engaged in medical, pastoral, educational and social works. Service to the local Church was epitomized this past year when a local group of women—guided by Maryknoll Sisters in their formation for religious life—were formally erected as an independent diocesan congregation.

New ecumenical efforts were initiated with a Sister teaching Community Service in the Presbyterian Bible School. Sister also belongs to the Women's League of Nationalist China helping organize and sustain a job training center for the handicapped. The Sisters collaborate in a full-time apostolate for young factory workers and youth leadership training programs.
