# Midtown Ministry Starts Counseling

A free counseling service for people employed in the midtown area of Rochester has been established by the Midtown Ministry, an ecumenical group of clergymen from five churches.

The service is a result of consultation between business leaders in the Midtown Plaza area and the clergy of churches within the inner loop east of the Genesee River.

The Employee Counseling Service opened this week in Suite 1503 of the Midtown Tower Hotel.

### SPECIAL LECTURE

Dom Jean LeClerc, OSB, will deliver the St. Bernard Lecture to note the 800th anniversary of St. Bernard of Clairvaux's canonization on Dec. 4, at 7:30 p.m. at St. Bernard's Seminary. The lecture, which is free and open to the public, is titled *Mysticism, Medieval and Modern*. The latter half of the talk will deal with Thomas Merton and oriental mysticism. The lecture is sponsored by the seminary's Department of Continuing Education.

According to Dr. Craig Wright, manager of Health Services and medical director for Xerox, Corp., the counseling will most benefit "distraught or troubled persons" who do not require medical or psychiatric services. "This is where the Midtown Ministry fills a void, because quite frankly, in these areas we (doctors) aren't very good," he said.

The clergymen involved in the project are:

Father Charles A. Bennett, St. Mary's Church; the Rev. Charles D. Broadbent and the Rev. Douglas P. Sutphin, Salem United Church; Canon John T. Docker, Christ Church Cathedral; the Rev. Walter B. Freed, D.D., Reform-

mation Lutheran Church; and Father Paul J. Gibbons, Our Lady of Victory Church. The counseling suite is provided by Midtown Tower Hotel.

The venture, Father Bennett said, has evinced "whole hearted enthusiasm" from the downtown business community.

Mr. Freed cited the "evangelical" purpose of the mission, to answer the questions of man in the light of "Christian beliefs as against this new humanism that passes for religion."

Canon Docker pointed out that the service will also refer persons with more serious distress to agencies equipped for that purpose.

Appointments may be made by calling 232-3030. The service will operate Monday through Wednesday noon.

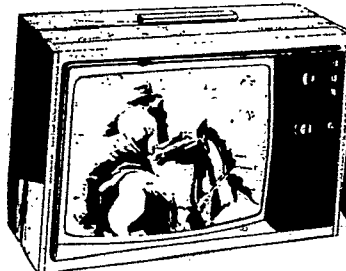

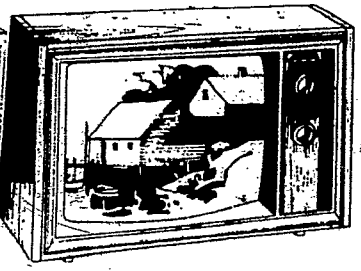

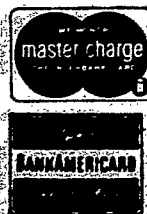
