Originated in Spain, Marriage Encounter was introduced to the U.S. at the 1967 meeting of the Christian Family Movement. It is estimated that each month 4,500 couples in the U.S. take part in Marriage Excounter weekends. Most are under auspices of religious groups, although there is particular denominational content to the program.

BISHOP DIES

Raleigh, N.C. [RNS] — Bishop Vincent S. Waters, for 30 years head of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Raleigh, died Dec. 3 at his residence, apparently of a heart attack. He was 70. The prelate, who was a strong sup-

porter of racial integration prior to the peak civil rights years and spurred ecumenical awareness in his diocese, was named to head the Raleigh See in 1945 when it covered all of North Carolina. The diocese was divided in 1972 to form the Western North Carolina diocese of Charlotte.
