The Sacrament of Anointing will be administered at afternoon Masses in three parishes on the next three Sundays.

St. Rita Church in West Webster will be the gathering point at 3 p.m. May 18 for the ill and elderly of that parish and its neighbors — Holy Trinity, Holy Spirit and St. Paul. People with transportation problems may call any of the parishes listed.

City parishes of the Southwest Region will take part in the liturgy at 3 p.m. May 25 at St. Monica's. Included are St. Lucy's, Immaculate Conception, Ss. Peter

and Paul, St. Augustine and Good Counsel.

On June 8, also at 3 p.m., the sacrament will be offered at St. Thomas More Church in Brighton. Parishioners' friends, relatives and neighbors are invited to join them in the Eucharist.
