place of Father Otto Vogt, who was reassigned last week to Honeoye Falls.

No successor has been named for Guardian Angels, which, unlike the smaller Steuben County parishes, has a staff. The Henrietta parish, guided by Father Kleintjes through its 15 years, has church, rectory, school, convent and hall.

Father Kleintjes, ordained in 1939, entered the service chaplaincy during World War II and served with the Navy in the Philippine Islands for two years. A native of Auburn, he attended St. Alphonsus School and Auburn High School before entering the diocesan seminaries.

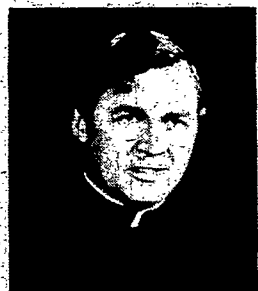

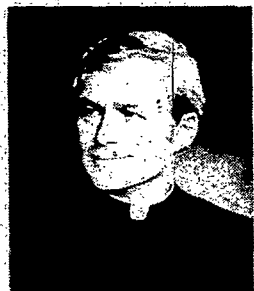
