


The subject of Patricia Hearst has been one of the most talked about and written about subjects of the past year and a half,

Some people think her kidnapping was not staged. They believe that by some means the SLA (Symbionese Liberation Army) converted Patty into a revolutionist. Others believe that Patty was a member of the SLA before her kidnapping.

After 19 months with the SLA she is being arraigned for such charges as armed bank robbery and violation of the Federal Fire-Arms Act. These are only two.of the 22 charges she may have to face.

What really happened to Patty Hearst? Could she have so easily turned around two months after she was kidnapped and called her parents and fiancee "pigs"?
