Canada Mail Embargoed

Postmaster William E. Finn announced that effective immediately an embargo has been placed on all classes of mail, both surface and air, destined for Canada, due to strike conditions in that country.

All mail for Canada will be returned to the sender.

Postage will be refunded on mail returned due to the suspension of service, Finn said. Customers must submit the envelope or wrapper when filing for the postage refund. This can be done at any classified Station, Branch or the Main Post Office.

The Postmaster emphasized this is a total embargo and no mail will be accepted at any Post Office for Canada.
