Geneva Chest Joins United Way System

Geneva — The Board of Directors of the Geneva Community Chest has voted to join the United Way system for this region established last spring by the United Community Chest of Greater Rochester, according to Frederick W. Shepard, president of the Geneva Community Chest, and Burton S. August, UCC president.

In addition to the United Community Chest in Monroe County, the new area-wide United Way system includes the United Way of Ontario County and the United Way of Wayne County. This regional approach to planning and fund raising may ultimately also include United Ways from three other counties as well.

"On behalf of the officers and the board of directors of the United Community Chest," August said, "we are very pleased that the volunteer leadership of the Geneva Community Chest has voted to work with us in the new area-wide system. I am very enthusiastic about the cooperation that we will be receiving from the Geneva area. The Chest there has a long tradition of providing excellent service to the community. Shepard emphasized that although the Chest in Geneva will become part of the area-wide system, it will continue to maintain its local office and Geneva volunteers will continue to decide allocations to local agencies.
