The award is a papal honor bestowed on laity to acknowledge outstanding service to the church. Pope Paul VI granted the award at the request of Bishop Leo Maher of the Diocese of San Diego.

Mrs. Kraft's family were active in the Catholic church in Rochester during the formation of the diocese, and assisted in the founding of St. Patrick's Cathedral, the original cathedral in Rochester.
