Dear Father Hohman,

I too, am "middle-aged" and sometimes when I hear one of my peers speak disparagingly of "changes in the church," I feel something of what Jesus must have felt when He wept over Jerusalem. Don't you realize, C. N., that the liturgy is an invitation to the "Wedding Feast!" Invitations to secular weddings are sometimes different from the "traditional", but it doesn't make

the wedding any different; two people are still united under God. Well, Jesus is inviting us to His Wedding Feast. He is the Bridegroom, pleading with us to come join with Him as His bride. You mentioned Fr. Andrew Greeley in your letter. Please go to the public library and get his book "The Jesus Myth" and read it prayerfully.
No matter how many changes may occur in the liturgy, 'Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever.' [Heb. 13:8]

Please pray and ask God's help, so you can accept all the beautiful things that Vatican II has wrought.

Thank you very much for your letter in regard to the changes in the liturgy. As you are well aware this whole matter becomes completely controversial the minute it is brought up. There are people on both sides but I feel that your expression is very much


to the point and very spiritual. I'm afraid that a lot of people simply feel as though they have been cheated. They feel that they were told that a certain way of doing things was the only way and then subsequently were told that wasn't necessarily the way at all. It must be a bitter pill for certain individuals to swallow and I think that, as we live in a time when healing as a part of our ministry is coming to the forefront, we must not forget the legions of people who need healing because the changes were just too difficult to accept. I do not wish to be or sound patronizing when I say that, but rather recognize that we all are different and react differently to various events. I pray that the riches of the new liturgy will not be lost on those who have suffered from the loss of the old.
