Parish Cookbook Seen 'Sensitizer'

Auburn — The human development committee at St. Alphonsus Parish has produced a cookbook of meatless recipes to help sensitize parishioners to the needs of the poor. Proceeds from the sale will be used for people in need.

Mrs. Kathie Fox, chairperson, indicated the cookbook contains some thoughts for a meatless diet for people who want to do something about the problems of world hunger, and it increases awareness of the hunger problems in the local area.

"Responsibly sharing the reality of food scarcity and learning to cook in ways which combat scarcity for the people of the world can be a significant step towards answering the call of Christ to feed the hungry and build brotherhood among all the people of our world," the committee states in the preface.

Mrs. Fox said the cookbook evolved with committee concern over figures showing how much grain it takes to produce one pound of beef or chicken as compared with the numbers of people who can be fed by the grain.

Different committee projects, a sharing supper and the cookbook, focussed on people in far away countries, she said. Then the committee began to realize the needs in Auburn.

She said taking a bag of food to a family to tide them over is just a "band-aid" approach.
