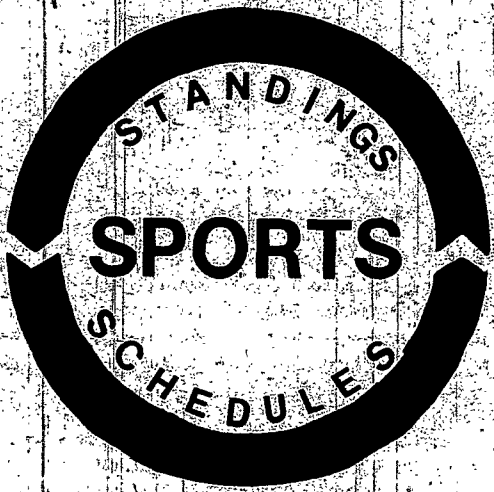

Equal Time conducted 320 student interviews.

RapAround has encouraged student contributions through its SpeakOut column which has presented 40 individual articles pertaining to what the student themselves consider important.

John Doser through his sports column keeps everyone in the know about the various school athletic teams, who, when and where they play as well as their league standings.

Also, his weekly features give RapAround readers an in-depth look into the sports world and all of its aspects — coaching, playing, winning and losing.

RapAround's feature articles have covered a multitude of events

(an estimated 110) which keep the high schools beehives of activity; band concerts, jazz sessions, Christian community services, debates, magic shows, pep rallies, auditions, scientific programs — the list is endless.

RapAround has presented its readers a varied format by leaving the school scene on occasion in order to include special features like the personal interviews with Bobby Chandler, wide receiver for the Buffalo Bills and Seals and Crofts the popular folk-rock group.

In its reporting on teenage legal rights, the job market, and books RapAround has been an informational service to our young adults.
