Monk Named Britain Primate

London [RNS] — Pope Paul has named a 52-year-old Benedictine monk as the ninth Archbishop of Westminster and Roman Catholic Primate of England and Wales. He is Father Basil Hume, Abbot of Ampleforth Benedictine Abbey in Yorkshire County, northern England.

The first monk ever named to head the Westminster archdiocese, Abbot Hume succeeds the late Cardinal John Heenan, who died in November.

Archbishop-designate Hume, born March 23, 1923, at Newcastle-on-Tyne, was baptized John Bernard and took the name Basil on entering the Benedictine order.

His father, the late Sir William Hume, a non-Catholic and a physician, was a well-known heart specialist. His French-born Roman Catholic mother lives in Newcastle.

Archbishop-designate Hume, by his appointment, becomes spiritual leader of an archdiocese that has some 500,470 Catholics, over 900 priests, 214 parishes, and 79 church-run charitable and 260 educational institutions.

The new Catholic Primate of England and Wales, according to the Vatican, is an enthusiastic sports fisherman and a staunch supporter of Newcastle's football club.

Deaths

W. H. Gilman

The Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated last Thursday at Blessed Sacrament Church for William H. Gilman, a scholar of international repute, who had taught at the University of Rochester since 1947.

Prof. Gilman, who had been on leave this term because of his health, died Feb. 16, 1976, at his home in Canterbury Road. He was 64 years old.

He was regarded widely as a leading authority on the works of Ralph Waldo Emerson and Herman Melville. At the university, he was Roswell S. Burrows professor of English.

His work in the community centered on the improvement of race relations through the efforts of several organizations active in the 1960s. He was president of the Catholic Inter-racial Council, 1964-66, and a member of the Park-Meigs Interfaith Council and the Blessed Sacrament Council on Racial Justice. As a member of the subcommittee on housing of the Monroe County Human Relations Commission, he wrote the commission's "open occupancy pledge" in 1964.

Dr. Gilman was born in Boston and educated at Harvard, George Washington University and Yale, from which he received his doctorate.

He leaves his widow, the former Margaret Cox Reilly, and six children, Barbara, Christopher, Margaret, Kathleen, Lucia and Stephen.
