# Special Prayer for Chrism Mass

Father Timothy McCough has written a Chrism Mass prayer especially for those who will not be able to be present at the service at Ss. Peter & Paul's Church, Elmira, on Tuesday, April 13, at 8 p.m.

The idea behind the prayer has been defined by Father McCough as follows, "Those imable to attend will be able to renew their commitment to ministry to service of God and of neighbor. The renewal of this commitment is a part of the Chrism service! The peoples of the various regions who would like to have the community of Christ reach into their lives may place this scrollin an appropriate place during the time of the service so that it may be recited by the ill, infirm and others unable to be present and lifted up with the prayers of those at Ss. 
