

### CFM Drug Abuse Course

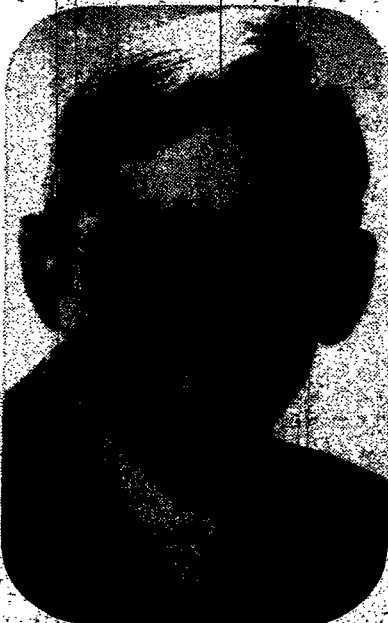
