Everyone agrees it's a fun way to take a final examination and from the exuberance and professionalism with which they work to produce a fine presentation, they should have no worry about passing it.

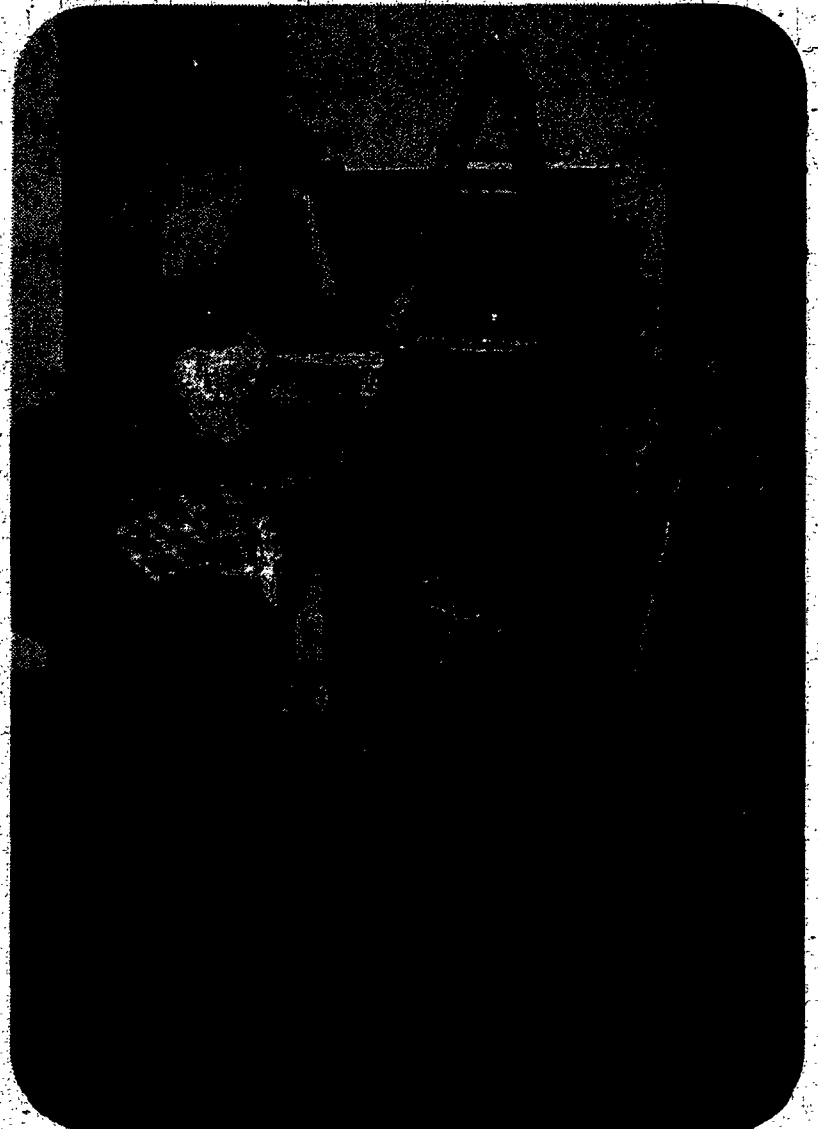
