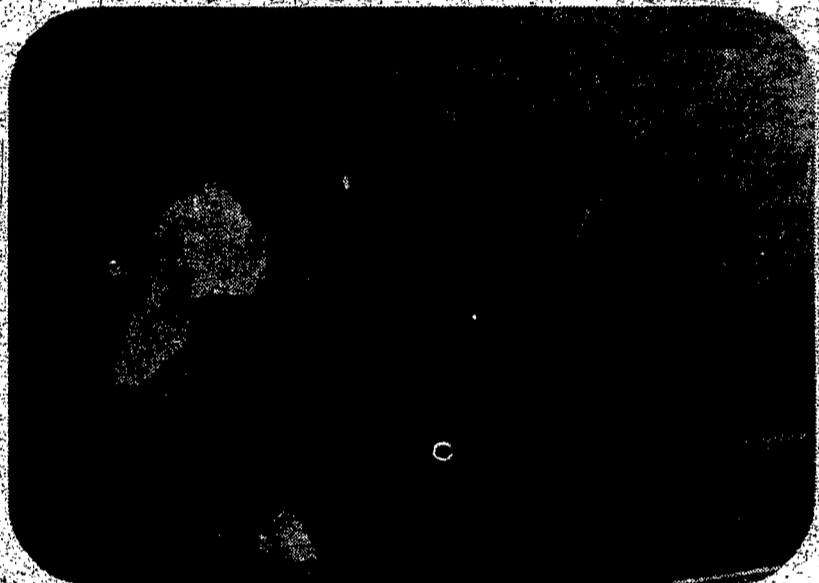


Active Aquinas students include Kevin Donovan who won the local Optimist speech finals and placed second in States; and Pat Culhane who was vice president of Debating Team.
